

6th GRADE**SCIENCE**

Mr. Corah /Mr. Windmiller

The science classes in the 6th grade are now into their study of our solar system. We start the month looking at why the moon causes eclipses and our ocean's tides. We are then going to move into our study of the rest of our solar system with a breakout game that will lead students across the Milky Way and require them to use their knowledge of science to save the day.

February will also include our first CPA of this unit. Details were handed out on January 27th and the projects are due in class on February 13th!

MATH

Mrs. Silveus/Mr.Koehlinger

Academic classes will start the month by jumping ahead to Modules 11 and 12 Solving Equations and Inequalities. Very little mental math will be used to solve the equations!!! Showing the steps is important to prove deep understanding of the problem and is also required on the ILearn test to gain the most points on the grading rubric (partial credit). Accelerated classes will be working on Modules 17 and 18 Using Slope to solve problems. Also a review of all operations without a calculator and integrating fractions and decimals to ensure students have a solid understanding to solve these type of problems. Continue to study hard and commit yourself to getting work in on time.

SOCIAL STUDIES

The students did a fantastic job on their Ancient Greece projects. It was awesome seeing their creativity on display. In February our focus will shift to Ancient Rome. We will have another project that goes along with this unit as well. Please help your kids plan their time on completing the projects. WHAT IS RELAY FOR LIFE?

Relay is a team fundraising event where team members take turns walking around a track. Our event is 7 hours in length and each team is asked to have a member on the track at all times to signify that cancer never rests. Cancer patients don't stop because they're tired, and for one night, neither do we.

Each team sets up a themed campsite at the event and continues their fundraising efforts by selling foods, goods, games, and activities. This money will count towards their overall team fundraising goal.
