

CMS Dress Code Quick Reference Sheet

1. Holes at or below the knee are permitted in pants. No holes permitted in shirts. (Holes in jeans/shirts that have been properly patched with non-flesh colored material will be allowed.)
2. Low cut neck lines are prohibited. (staff discretion)
3. Blouses and tops that are see-through, strapless, or expose undergarments and/or bare midriffs are prohibited.
4. No hats or sunglasses except on “special school days.”
5. Pajama pants are not to be worn. (drawstring / elastic trousers without zippers or belt loops made of fleece, flannel, silk, or similar material constitute pajamas)
6. Clothing or other items worn by students that contain inappropriate or suggestive wording are not permitted.
7. Proper footwear must be worn. Bedtime slippers are not allowed.
8. Skirts and dresses should be appropriate in length. Skirts and dresses are to be no more than 3” from the center of the knee cap. Tights/leggings are only allowed when worn with dresses/skirts/shorts that extend to mid-thigh.
